

Authorship and Contribution Policy (Summary)

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The Contribution-Based Model

ICResG follows a contribution-based authorship model. Membership in the research group does not automatically guarantee authorship of publications or research outputs — authorship is earned through meaningful intellectual and technical contributions.

Recognised Contributions

Contributions that may merit authorship include, among others: conception and design of the research; development of software, models or datasets; analysis and interpretation of results; and substantive drafting or critical revision of the output.

Authorship versus Acknowledgment

Individuals who do not make substantial contributions will not be included as authors but may receive appropriate acknowledgment where applicable. This approach ensures fairness, transparency, accountability and academic integrity across all ICResG research activities.

Application

This policy applies to every ICResG output: peer-reviewed publications, conference papers, technical reports, software solutions, datasets, prototypes and other research-driven innovations.
